LLAMA REQUIREMENTS

RULES/REGULATIONS: Entries made in this division shall be subject to and each exhibitor agrees to abide by the General Rules and Regulations and Department Requirements as published in this premium list. This show is an Alpaca and Llama Show Association (ALSA) approved show sponsored by South Central Llama Association (SCLA). All rules and guidelines for this show not covered by the State Fair of Texas Rules and Regulations will be in accordance to the current ALSA Handbook. The State Fair of Texas Llama Show is a qualifier for the annual Central Regional ALSA Championship show.

ENTRY APPLICATION/FEE: An entry application and fee of \$20 per class plus an ALSA show fee of \$5 per head, and all stall fees must be submitted by entry deadline. All fees must accompany online applications for entry or mailed in signature forms. This fee is not a stall fee. Late entries will be accepted until September 15, for a late entry fee per head equal to two times the regular entry fee per head.

An ALSA membership card must be presented at registration check or a \$30 fee for adults/\$15 fee for youth must be paid to receive exhibitor’s entry packet.

A copy of all entry forms and registrations must be sent to: Bob Burton, PO Box 1194, Grandview, TX 76050-1194 by September 1.

GROUP ENTRIES: Group classes are denoted by a “G” after the class number. A \$5 additional entry fee is required for each group class entered by entry deadline. A late fee equal to two times the regular group class entry fee is required for group class entries made after the entry deadline. **GROUP CLASS ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE REGISTRATION CHECK DEADLINE.** All animals entered in a group class must be shown in their respective individual class. The dam, sire or breeder represented **MUST** be named on the entry application. Do **NOT** name the individual animals entered in the group.

OWNERSHIP: Exhibitors must be the registered owners and make entry in the exact names (owner and animal) as they appear on the registration certificate. An exhibitor may or may not be the handler. Youth division entries must be made in the name of the youth.

REGISTRATION: An original certificate of registration must be presented to the superintendent prior to the registration check deadline and kept available at all times during the show for each animal exhibited.

All llamas, with the exception of in youth, performance and non-breeder classes, must be registered or have passed screening with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC).

All llamas have to be registered with the ILR.

Non-breeding llamas and llamas used in youth or performance classes do not have to be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or CLRC.

STALLS/BEDDING: Stall fee of \$50 per stall, limit two head per stall not including cria 5 mos. or younger, must be submitted with entry application by entry deadline. No bedding provided.

Special and specific stall requests must be submitted on the Stall Request Form included in this premium list by September 15. There is no guarantee that any stall request can or will be honored.

WOOL DIVISIONS: Llamas will be divided into three divisions based on length of wool.

Light Wool: Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs.

Medium Wool: Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

Heavy Wool: Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool. (i.e., leg wool at least to knee and hock.)

Light and medium wools may be combined to have at least eight entries in the division. This will allow these entries to be eligible to show and receive points for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion

NON-BREEDER: All ages and wool classifications of gelded males or surgically spayed females to be judged on soundness, conformation, a disposition.

Non-breeding llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying gelded or spayed status.

If three or less entries per class, classes may be combined.

INTERMEDIATE/MASTER PERFORMANCE: Open to all entries who meet the specific criteria for the respective ALSA approved class. A llama may be entered only once in either intermediate/master or youth classes.

NOVICE PERFORMANCE: Open to all entries who meet the specific criteria for the respective ALSA approved class. A llama may be entered in only either novice or youth classes.

YOUTH: All youth ages 8 through 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year. A youth who becomes 8 during the year is eligible to show as of his/her birthday. For youth performance and showmanship classes, ALSA points will be credited to the handler. Youth ALSA number must be included on entry application.

The age divisions at any show may be combined if there are fewer than 8 total entries in any two of the age categories.

SPECIAL NEEDS (as described in ALSA Rulebook) will be combined with youth junior performance classes, but will be judged separately.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR: Premier Exhibitor will be calculated from the exhibitor's placement, in individual classes only, as follows: 4 points for each 1st, 3 points for each 2nd, 2 points for each 3rd, and 1 point for each 4th. In case of a tie, 5th place will count.

No entry fee, premium, or ALSA points. Llamas may not be entered more than once in the same class.
